### **Alectra Utilities-Electrical Safety and Conservation**

On March 18th, presenters from Alectra Utilities will be at St. Margaret Mary.

Students in grades JK-3 will meet "Wires" the safety puppet and learn 15-20 safety & conservation messages that they are able to take home to their parents. The students will receive a visual of how electricity works and some hands-on activities to give them a better understanding of safety & conservation.

### **Kindergarten Registration Reminder**

St. Margaret Mary C.E.S. offers Full Day Kindergarten. This means the Junior and Senior Kindergarten Programs run every day, Monday through Friday, from 9:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. This program is called the Full Day Kindergarten Program by the Ministry of Education.

- Junior Kindergarten (JK) children must be 4 years old by December 31, 2024 (born in 2020).
- Senior Kindergarten (SK) children must be 5 years old by December 31, 2024 (born in 2019).

The following original documents are required:

- Roman Catholic Baptismal Certificate;
- Birth Certificate;
- Proof of Canadian Citizenship or Landed Immigrant Status or other valid Legal Status if not born in Canada (with entry date into Canada);
- Proof of Residency (3 pieces). Two utility bills and one tax bill or purchase/lease agreement.
