#### **KINDERGARTEN REGISTRATION**

St. Margaret Mary. offers Full Day Kindergarten for all of our Junior and Senior Kindergarten classes. This means the Junior and Senior Kindergarten Programs run every day, Monday through Friday, from 9:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. The full day Kindergarten class has a Kindergarten teacher and an Early Childhood Educator, administering a play-based learning program.

Registration begins in January 2025. Junior Kindergarten (JK) children must be 4 years old by December 31, 2025 (born in 2021). Senior Kindergarten (SK) children must be 5 years old by December 31, 2025 (born in 2020). The following original documents are required: Roman Catholic Baptismal Certificate; Birth Certificate; Proof of Canadian Citizenship or Landed Immigrant Status or other valid Legal Status if not born in Canada (with entry date into Canada); Proof of Residency (3 pieces). Two utility bills and one tax bill or purchase/lease agreement. If you have any questions about Full Day Kindergarten for your child, please contact the school office.

<u>PARKING LOT SAFETY DURING THE WINTER MONTHS</u> As the winter months are upon us, a reminder to all parents/guardians to take extra precaution when driving in/out and through the school parking lot. Please be courteous and patient as wait times may be increased due to the weather and driving conditions.
