WINTER WEATHER REMINDERS

All students are expected to go outside for recess. Therefore, children need to come to school dressed warmly in order to spend the 40 minute lunchtime recess outdoors. During inclement weather (see below) the children will stay inside, but such days or times are not always predictable. Please ensure that your child(ren) has a winter jacket, hat, gloves or mittens, scarf, snow pants or slush pants and winter boots. Please ensure any loose fixtures on the clothing such as Velcro and strings are secure. It is also important that you mark your child's name on each item of clothing. It is highly suggested that you send an extra pair of socks and gloves, and a change of clothes in the event that the ones they are wearing become damp or wet. Please ensure that all students have indoor shoes, and that the soles are non-marking. Thank you for your cooperation.

INDOOR INCLEMENT WEATHER

The students will have outdoor recess routines when the temperature is -17 $^{\circ}$ C (with the wind chill). They will go outdoors for both am and pm recesses and for 1/2 the lunch recess; the other 1/2 of recess will be indoors. At -18 $^{\circ}$ C (with the wind chill), they will be indoors every recess. We will check the Weather Network temperature with wind chill just before the recess break and this temperature will be logged each time.
