Who was St. Margaret Mary?

St. Margaret Mary Alacoque was a French nun who lived in the 17th century. She was born in 1647 and grew up in a religious family. From a young age, she had a strong devotion to God and wanted to dedicate her life to serving Him.

As a young woman, St. Margaret Mary entered the Visitation Convent in Paray-le-Monial, France. During her time there, she had several mystical experiences and visions of Jesus Christ. In these visions, Jesus revealed His Sacred Heart to her, a symbol of His immense love and mercy for all humanity.
